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Arkéa Flex and Foncia inaugurate their first progressive housing project in Tours

Arkéa Flex, a subsidiary of Crédit Mutuel Arkéa and a pioneer in the construction of flexible, adaptable housing, and Foncia, 1er syndic de France, have inaugurated the region's very first fully modular condominium in the Monconseil eco-neighbourhood in Tours, built by developer Crescendo and designed by MU architecture. With flats that can be upgraded and customised to meet changing lifestyles, this co-ownership embodies a new vision of housing, with sustainable buildings that avoid the need for major renovation or rebuilding work.

As a market leader, Foncia has long been **thinking about the housing of the future**, based on greater adaptability and flexibility. The innovative Tours condominium embodies this new generation of adaptable housing that will be able to





change size according to occupants' needs. Thanks to Arkéa Flex's patented technology, the purchase or sale of condominium lots will make it possible to enlarge or reduce the size of flats, from T1 to T5, to meet the needs of residents.

As a subsidiary of Crédit Mutuel Arkéa, Arkéa Flex's expertise is part of the **cooperative banking group's property business**. Created in 2023, this dedicated business line aims to promote responsible, protective real estate that serves local communities by supporting home ownership, accelerating energy and environmental transitions, and contributing to local vitality.

The first apartment block to benefit from Arkéa Flex technology, located at 12 rue du Père Goriot in Tours, has **271 cells ranging from 15 m² to 24 m²** with an average surface area of 21 m^2 . A total of **114 flats were** sold by Crescendo.

As the managing agent of this new co-ownership, Foncia will assist the successive owners with any work that may be required, and will ensure that it continues to evolve.
